IPAA QUEENSLAND OPENS AWARDS TO INDIVIDUALS FOR FIRST TIME

For the first time, individuals within the public sector will be recognised for their achievements as the Institute of Public Administration Australia (IPAA) Queensland opens nominations for the inaugural *Public Sector Excellence Awards* today.

Open to individuals and teams across all local, state and federal government agencies and organisations, the **IPAA Queensland Public Sector Excellence Awards** will recognise best practice and excellence in the public sector for the benefit of Queenslanders.

IPAA Queensland CEO Peter Rumph said the Awards will offer a refreshing and innovative initiative for the public sector and will promote cross-government relations between the three tiers of government.

“These are the first Awards of their kind to recognise all public sector employees across local, state and federal government agencies.

“We were looking for a way to promote both individual and team excellence and also wanted to recognise the integral role they play in contributing to a flexible and sustainable public sector in Queensland.

“It is what the public sector has been wanting - an Awards program which not only recognises teams, but individuals and their achievements too,” he said.

The **IPAA Queensland Public Sector Excellence Awards** provide a perfect opportunity to recognise and support those who have made outstanding contributions to their government agency, local government, the public sector in Queensland and the wider community.

Nominations open **today Monday 13 July 2009** and close **5pm Friday 4 September 2009**.

The Awards will complement the B150 and Q150 celebrations across the state, culminating in a gala night on Wednesday 7 October themed *‘reflecting on the future: celebrating 150 years of public service to Queensland.’*

“There is an Awards category suitable for everyone and I encourage all public sector professionals to nominate,” Mr Rumph said.
